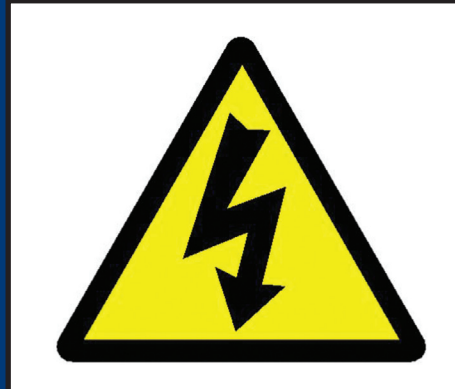

## Electrical Safety (NFPA 70E)

Electrical hazards on the job such as shock, electrocution, and arc flash are serious issues for the workplace. This course addresses electrical safety requirements that are necessary for the practical safeguarding of employees in their workplaces utilizing the 29 CFR 1910 OSHA and NFPA 70E standards. Participants will learn the relationship between OSHA and NFPA, hazard recognition, safe work practices around energy sources, static electricity dangers, and proper use of personal protective equipment.
